Pay less tuition: You can save per credit at most technical schools, community colleges and some 4-year schools.

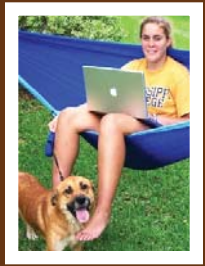
Sign up!
