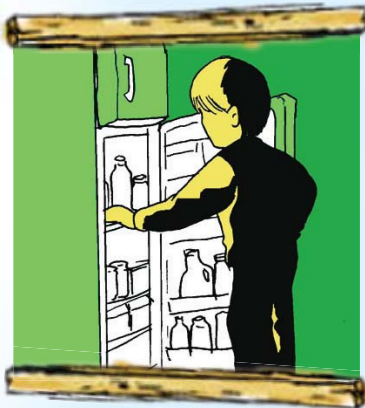




## Kids Make it Happen

Or cut images from magazines and glue them to a stiff piece of colorful heavy paper. (Ask your parents to bring you the throw-aways that are clean on one side from work.) Use a glue stick, and cover the entire back of the image you're gluing.

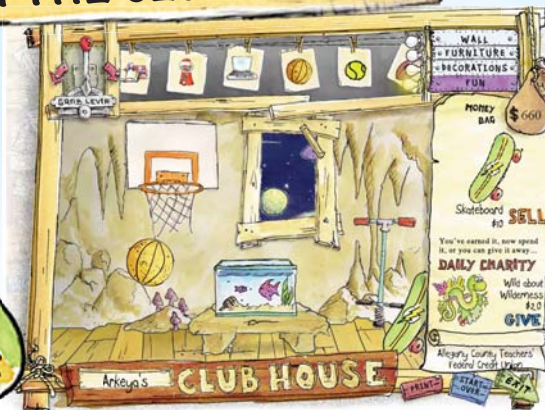
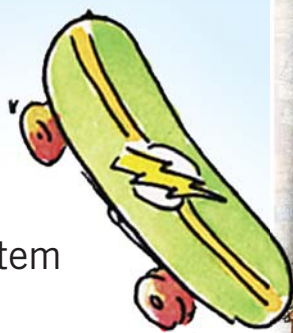
